Prince Alfred Win Tennis Cup

About 2,000 spectators saw Prince Alfred defeat St. Peter's, 14 rubbers, 28 sets, to 1 rubber, 3 sets in the annual intercollegiate tennis match played at Memorial Drive today. Princes showed ascendancy in both doubles and singles.

THE cup, presented by Mrs. J. H. Gosse, has been won by Princes 18 times since 1924.

In the opening doubles, Allen-Skewes, Saints' third pair, gave a surprising display against Princes' first double. Candy-Huelin. Skewes was particularly enterprising, but Candy-Huelin hit their way to victory when pressed.

Dowding-Steele (Saints No. 1 pair), appeared to be in trouble when trailing 3-5 and love-40, but Chapman-Stevens slumped at this stage, and with Dowding volleying cleverly, Saints won their only rubber at 6-5, 6-2.

Keith Huelin and Bob Skewes hit merrily in one of the most attractive singles of the day.

At the end of the morning session, Princes led 5 rubbers 10 sets, to Saints 1 rubber 2 sets.

DOUBLE FAULTS

In doubles after lunch, Candy-Huelin would have had to fight harder if Dowding, playing with Steele, had not lost services with a sequence of double faults. Both the Saints boys starred frequently in the rallies.

The three singles in which first, second, and third players in each team were opposed, resulted in hollow victories for Candy, Rowe, and Hockney.

Both Candy and Rowe hit forcefully, while Hockney relied on placements and an occasional trip to the net.
